Debbie welcomed all to the meeting. Mont announced that the snow day makeup day is scheduled for Friday February 15. This was previously a no student day at school. Chip noted that he has met with 3 members of the school board this week. They wanted to see our school before they vote. Voting for the fate of our school will be on February 8 at the school board meeting.

The previous meetings minutes were reviewed. Debbie asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Margaret motioned to approve and Debbie seconded. The minutes were approved.

The midterm SRI and SMI data was reviewed. There has been great improvement in the percentage of students reaching "typical or above typical." Notable growth is seen in each quadrant. A discussion was had about increasing the current goal of 60% with the new strides made. Mont suggested to leave the goal at 60% and look to exceed that number for a couple years before increasing it. The goal will stay the same and, when needed, an addendum to increase can be made.

The CSIP and Land Trust goals were discussed. It was decided to keep our Land Trust money going toward interventionists. 10 of 12 positions are filled and going well. Halfway through the year and the money is about halfway spent. There is to be no more than 10% held over from year to year and we should meet that perfectly. There had usually been a technology portion. Currently Chip says the school can maintain and rotate old stuff out, and new in with different funds. Steve motioned to approve the CSIP and Land Trust. Debbie seconded. There was a vote with all ayes. The CSIP and Land TRust was approved. This will be signed at the March meeting for final approval by April 8.

Professional development needs and plans to support school goals was discussed. Professional development is proceeding smoothly. There will a 3 month calendar to the teachers. There will be focus on specific topics and things will remain the same. This gives the teacher a chance to get really good at it before more is added. The Social and Emotional team is complete and running at full capacity.

The Child Access Routing Plan and Space Available Bussing was discussed. Chip has been trying to get a date as to when the state plans to block the underpass on Wasatch for the freeway expansion. The preference is during the summer. Chip will also ask planning and enrollment.
