 - i. Did not make it and actually went from a D to an F
 - c. 2017-18 worked on a restructuring plan so that the state does not:
 - i. SB 235
 1. Close school
 2. Make it a Charter
 3. State assumes control of school
 4. Rotate admin and ½ teachers
 - d. 2018-19 implemented restructuring plan
 - i. Got a 2 year extension from the state based on growth data
 - e. 2019-20 2nd year of extension to get our letter grade up to a C and get out of the bottom 5%
